

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE

IN THE IRISH NATIONAL WATERSKI OR WAKEBOARD CHAMPIONSHIPS ?

RULE CLARIFICATION

In any sport, transferring from one country to another and then being eligible to compete in the National Championships of the new home is often a difficult topic. The old Federation may not want to lose you and the new one does not wish to be unfair to the athlete concerned. As many people have moved homes in Europe in recent years, following a recent survey of Federations in our sport in this EAME Region, the Irish Waterski Federation has now brought its Eligibility Rule into line with the International Water Ski Federation and other neighbouring countries to both simplify and clarify the situation for all.

If a Skier / Rider is not eligible to hold an Irish Passport he / she must prove, to the satisfaction of the Irish Water Ski Federation, residency on the island of Ireland for at least five years concurrent with full membership of a Club affiliated to the
