GENERAL SUMMARY OF JUDGING EXAMINATIONS

Thank you for attending the 11th Annual International EAME Wakeboard Judging and Officials Seminar hosted by the Irish Waterski Federation and EAME Wakeboard.

With a quality number of 18 dedicated officials from 7 countries proved the weekend to be a great success, it was encouraging to see 12 people sit the 4 levels of examination including a practical video test and also the calculation examination.

The International Wakeboard Session was again aimed at judges with experience and at a high level, the purpose of this report is to give a brief summary to all of the results and errors as, unfortunately we cannot evaluate each individual paper.

Interaction over the weekend was very good with the correct questioning of the judging process and procedures, at all levels, which is most encouraging.

The results of the written paper were good and well received, some small mistakes, especially regarding names of tricks. Regarding international level 2, some tricks were missed, and it is important that further studying of the tricks is required. The International level 1 written exam was very good overall, some details much needed still missing, but nothing that more experience judging international events doesn't solve.

Regarding the video analysis, at National Level, some judges are still confusing rotations, some basic inverts, especially the ones that have added rotations. Also the difference between heelside and toeside tricks needs to be better marked. Almost all got a whirlybird correctly, which shows good recognition of some more difficult tricks at this level.

International level 2 still confused some tricks as well, although the level of judging was considered high, the obstacles marking was very positive. International Level 1 was also very good overall, just some mistakes, but considered acceptable due to the high level of riding presented.

If you were not successful in the examination please do not be discouraged, it essential that time is spent in the boat for practice. Thank you all again for attending and we look forward to seeing you in the summer of 2009. A special thank you from Nuno and myself to Des Burke Kennedy and Barry Gavin who organized the seminar and were excellent hosts and thanks to Rui and Linda for helping with the administration.
